Scholarships for internships at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Targu Mures, Romania in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility offers 2 scholarships for students from the University of Sfax (Medicine) for a traineeship stay at The University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Targu Mures, Romania.

The purpose of this call for nominations is to select <u>2 students</u> for academic and traineeship stay at the <u>University of Medicine</u>, <u>Pharmacy</u>, <u>Science and Technology of Targu Mures</u>, <u>Romania</u> under the framework of the Erasmus+ programme Key Action KA.

Students can carry out internships at George Emil Palade University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Targu Mures, Romania and affiliated hospitals during **June-September 2025**; a placement mobility consists of **2 months**.

Mobility periods

2 months between June and September 2025

GENERAL CONDITIONS

The student internship or academic stay will unfold in accordance with the provisions of the Erasmus+ programme Guide.

The Home Universities will be in charge of selecting students and sending them to the University of University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Targu Mures, Romania.

The University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Targu Mures, Romania will evaluate whether the pre-selection meets the requirements of this call.

Financing

The Erasmus+ for study scholarships are contributions to support living costs in the hosting country. Monthly Scholarship: **850** €

Travel costs: 275 €

Pre-selection criteria at the home university

The home university will provide a pre-selection of candidates according to the following general criteria:

- Average grade.
- The consistency of the proposed activities.
- Language skills.
- Any other elements indicated by the student in the application (other learning experiences, specific academic interests, etc.).
- Additional criteria i.e: membership in science clubs or associations, participation in conferences and other mobility programmes etc. (it is up to the sending institution to include the criteria or not)
- Students who meet one or more of the following inclusion and diversity criteria established by the Erasmus+ program:
 - disability (i.e. participants with special needs): people with mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities;
 - educational difficulties: young people with learning difficulties; early school-leavers; low qualified adults; young people with poor school performance.
 - economic obstacles: people with a low standard of living, low income, dependence on social welfare system or homeless; young people in long-term unemployment or poverty; people in debt or with financial problems.
 - cultural differences: immigrants or refugees or descendants from immigrant or refugee families; people belonging to a national or ethnic minority; people with linguistic adaptation and cultural inclusion difficulties.
 - health problems: people with chronic health problems, severe illnesses, or psychiatric conditions.
 - social obstacles: people facing discrimination because of gender, age, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, disability, etc.; people with limited social skills or anti-social or risky behaviors; people in a precarious situation; (ex-)offenders, (ex-)drug or alcohol abusers; young and/or single parents; orphans.
 - geographical obstacles: people from remote or rural areas; people living in small islands or in peripheral regions; people from urban problem zones; people from less serviced areas (limited public transport, poor facilities).
